Evangelism 101: Becoming Fishers of Men Fall 2023

Course Description

The intention of this course is to equip the saints to faithfully share the Gospel and to start them on the journey of lifelong evangelism. It begins with the **heart** of evangelism, walks through various **approaches** to evangelism, provides some **overarching principles** in thinking about evangelism, then presents a **Gospel outline** for evangelism. However, we are called not just to speak the truth but to speak the truth in love. So in addition to a basic Gospel outline, the course will also provide "**fishing principles**" to help us understand *how* we should deliver truth.

Class Schedule

September 6 - Teaching Part 1: Evangelism Overview

This class will cover what evangelism means, the heart behind evangelism, different approaches to evangelism, and some overarching principles to evangelism.

Homework: Talk with a friend about which method of evangelism feels most and least comfortable, and which overarching principle stands out the most.

September 13, 20 - Teaching Part 2: Gospel Outline

These classes will cover a basic outline for sharing the Gospel and provide some wisdom for how to do it.

Homework: Memorize the five key verses for the Gospel outline, and practice them!

September 27 - Evangelism Skit!

This class we will perform a live skit of sharing the Gospel!

Homework: Share with someone who has been coming to church and fill out a summary!

October 18 - Sharing the Gospel Inside the Church

This class we will reconvene after you have shared with someone who has been coming to our church and discuss a few experiences.

Homework: Share with someone who hasn't been to our church and fill out a summary!

November 15 - Sharing the Gospel Outside the Church

This class we will reconvene again and discuss experiences.
